By the Books

In a typical year, UCI Libraries receive over **1.7 million physical visitors** to its five facilities: Langson Library, Science Library, Grunigen Medical Library, Law Library and Gateway Study Center. In 2020, UCI Libraries provided access to a total of **1,355,417 e-books, 1,478 databases and 232,432 serials** that can be used by students and faculty remotely.

A Storied Art Collection

An exquisite, unparalleled collection of nearly 5,000 paintings, sculptures and other pieces will make UCI's planned Institute and Museum for California Art **the nation's premier showcase for Golden State artwork**. The museum will house The Buck Collection, a wide-ranging trove that was willed to the university by developer Gerald Buck, and The Irvine Museum Collection, which consists of **more than 1,500 works of California plein-air art** amassed by the Irvine family. The museum will be dedicated to the exhibition, preservation and study of California art from the early 19th century to the present.



Online Learning Research Center

Created by UCI's School of Education, the Online Learning Research Center is led by prominent experts in online learning and was designed to provide **evidence-based resources, materials and guidelines for teachers and students** to improve academic achievement and equity in online learning.




UCI Black Thriving Initiative


